Srinagar is the summer capital of J&K and the campus is located in the heart of the Srinagar city, on NH1 Nowgam, which is at a distance of 10 Kms from the Sheikh ul Alam International Airport, Srinagar. The transit campus has in-campus residence facilities and is built as a center of excellence in the area of executive education and Entrepreneurship. The transit campus will also have an

incubation center promoting entrepreneurship in the region.
Kashmir is known as Switzerland of Asia and Srinagar as 'Heaven on Earth'. The picturesque city, located on the banks of river Jhelum, offers its visitors the best experience of time. 




Globalization has submerged the international boundaries across the globe. International firms operating in the present era need young and enthusiastic managers well-versed in the nuances and technicalities of the changing world.






1:00 pm






8:00 pm


9:30 pm






















EK BHARAT, SHRESHTHA BHARAT




